Munich Summer School of Applied Sciences

The Munich Summer School of Applied Sciences embraces an in-depth study in the fields of engineering and business.

The courses are application-orientated, employing state-of-the-art-technology and teaching methodology.

Engineering for Sustainability

The summer school is a five-week program. International students participate in an intensive German language and culture course in the first week and continue these studies part-time throughout the program.

Students will select two credit courses in the fields of Engineering and Business studies that are taught in English. The program includes guided tours, excursions to cultural and historical sites in the area of Munich as well as talks, company visits and festivities.

Courses

- German Language and Culture
Includes 51 contact hours plus relevant field trips (6 ECTS credits or 4 US-credits).
- Automotive Mechatronics
- Design of Lightweight Structure
- Renewable Energies
- Innovation and Entrepreneurship
- International Management

Each subject course includes 40 student-professor contact hours (4 ECTS-credits or 3 US-credits).

Requirements

- students of Engineering or Business studies
- Good English skills
- Letter of motivation
- Transcript of most recent grade point average

Fees

The program fee is € 2,490. It covers tuition for the German Language and Culture class, two subject courses, accommodation (incl. breakfast), the official cultural program, free internet access at the university and a welcome package. For students from partner universities, the fee is reduced to € 2,290.
